


# "Kendall Burdick's Recent Mission Trip"

by memorizing bible verses, being the first team to line up before and after meals, and during games. My team ended up winning camp! During camp, the connections with the kids were much stronger. I truly love each and every one of the kids I worked with. It was so special to see God working in their lives. These kids are broken, hurt, confused, and in serious need of love, but they know their Lord and Savior. Once camp was over, we then traveled back to Quito to do some more sightseeing and catch our flights home. I cannot thank you enough for the support- whether monetary or through prayer. This was truly a trip of a lifetime and I hope I can return one day. I look forward to sharing more about my trip soon!


